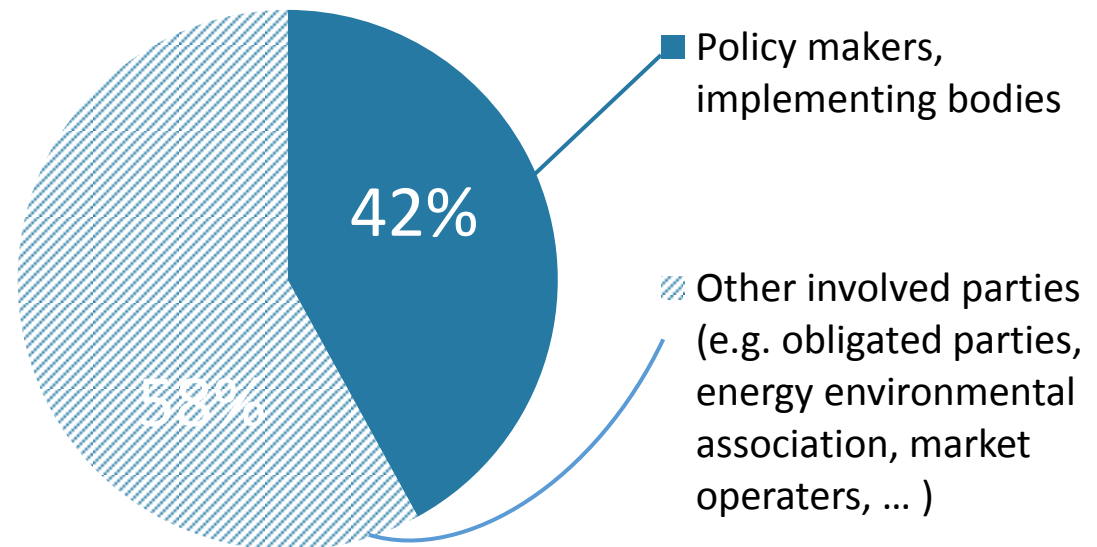

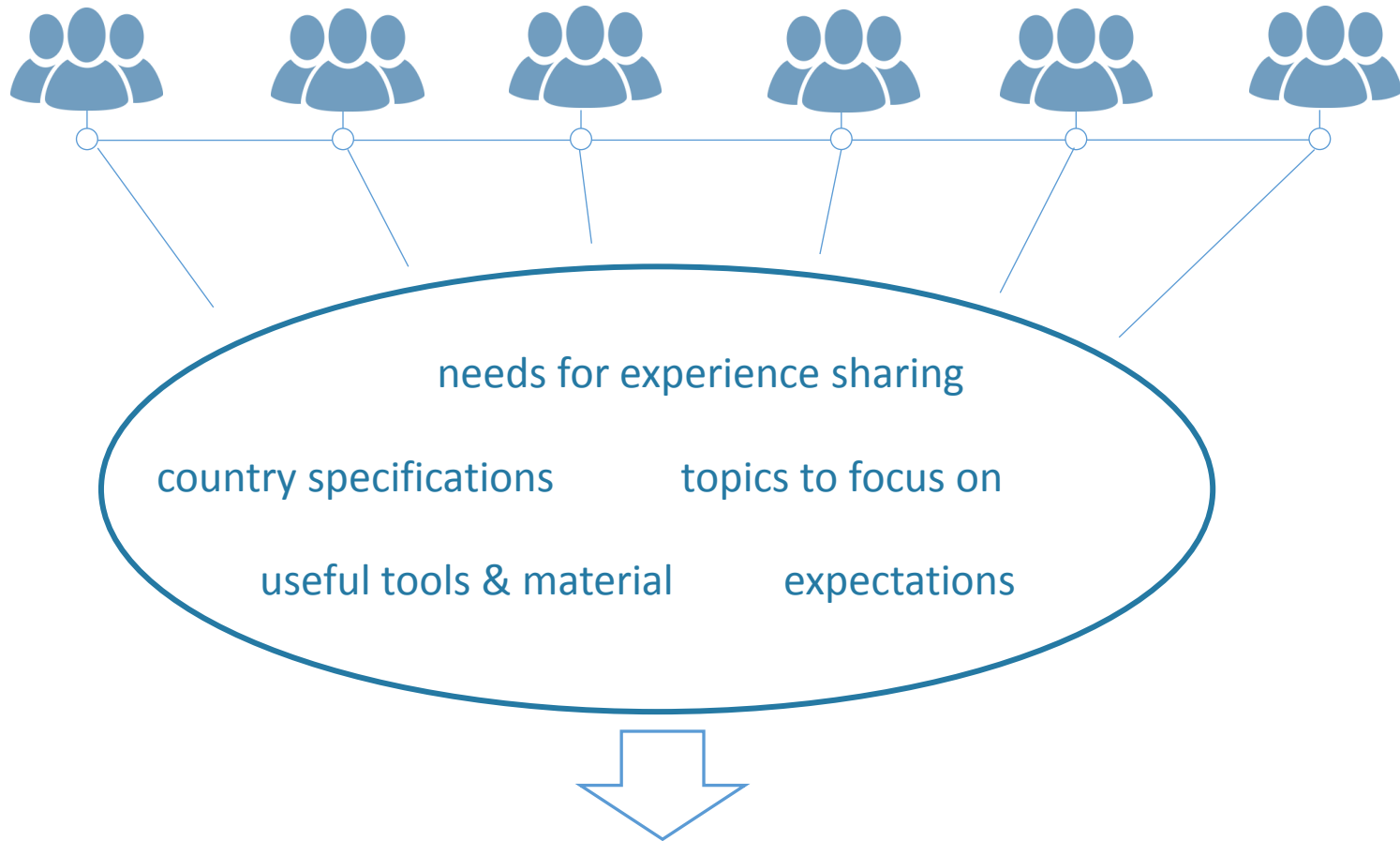

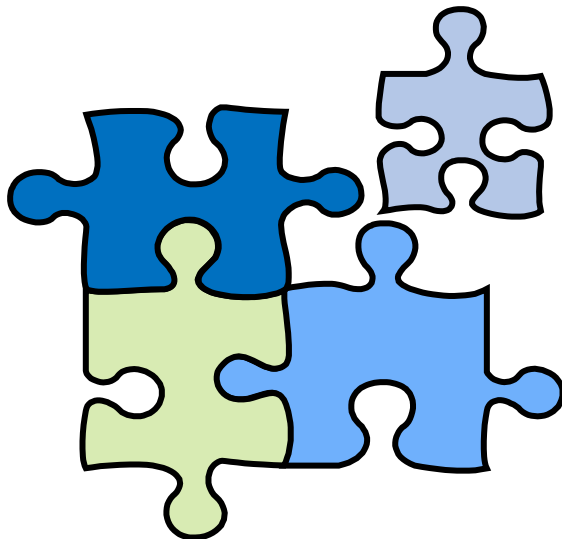

## Overview and specific knowledge exchange

### Overview

- ✓ Exchange between European countries about their approach for Article 7 EED



### Specific

- ✓ Small workshop groups for detailed discussions
- ✓ Specific tools for national use
- ✓ Consider national specifications and problems

- **Identification of topics** for knowledge exchange according to the priorities of policy makers/implementing bodies and all other involved stakeholders
- The **priorities** for knowledge sharing **differ according to the stage of implementation** of Art. 7 and national specifications, though some topics such as additionality and materiality are an issue at every stage
- Both stakeholder groups agree on topics like cost-effectiveness, financial sustainability and the need for robust MRV schemes. Stakeholder group II highlights the desire for being included in discussions
- Provide the opportunity to share experience in an international as well as in an intimate setting
